¹An assessment fee of \$900 per assessor day, plus travel related costs, is applicable for initial and annual on-site assessments of all IBC special inspection agencies. Assessor travel time is billed at the rate of \$700 per 8-hour day. Assessor preparation time (review of the quality management system manual, including technical review and preparation) for each on-site assessment is included in the basic fee. Actual on-site times will vary, depending on the agency's desired scope of accreditation.

An IBC special inspection agency can significantly reduce on-site assessment time (and costs) by having its documentation (training records, internal audits, management reviews, inspector monitoring records, inspection procedures, etc.) available for review by the assessor(s) in advance and by being adequately prepared to address any items requested in the assessment agenda including the scheduling of on-site visits to construction sites.

All Corrective Action Requests (CARs) generated during initial or annual assessment visits must be satisfactorily resolved prior to issuance of the accreditation certificate. In some cases, repeated exchanges of communication may be necessary to close out CARs. In some cases, when more than eight (8) hours of IAS staff time are needed to resolve CARs, an additional fee of \$100 per hour, or fraction thereof, will be charged.

²Accredited IBC special inspection agencies are subject to annual assessments.

³The basic fee includes one field of special inspection.

⁴Normally, an "additional field of inspection" is determined by the IAS categories of special inspection as defined in the Rules of Procedure for IBC® Special Inspection Agency Accreditation, e.g., structural, plumbing, electrical, fireproofing, etc.

NOTE: Additional fields of special inspection can be added to the scope of accreditation at any time. However, an on-site assessment may be required to confirm that the agency is competent in the new inspection field. The cost of on-site assessment is computed at the rate of \$900 per assessor day plus travel related expenses. Assessor travel time is billed at the rate of \$700 per 8-hour day. When an agency wishes to expand the scope of its accreditation, there is a minimum fee of \$450 for IAS review of the agency's request. If the request involves extensive revision/expansion of the current scope, IAS computes additional fees over the minimum at a rate of \$100 per hour of staff work.
