Those members who have already paid to attend ECA '20 will receive a refund of paid registration fees.





Although the email bears the FCIA logo at the bottom, it is a scam and is not from FCIA staff. The renewal process for 2020 Membership dues continues, but these "balance due request" emails

In this climate of escalating cybercrime and phishing scams, we urge everyone to look at the "From" email address before any action is taken on an email received. If the sender is not a recognized FCIA contact, do not click on or respond to any request for payment or account information. If you are unsure if a message originated from the FCIA staff, please contact us before you do anything requested in the email.

Rest assured that FCIA would never request bank account information or other confidential personal information from our membership. Keeping our members safe is important to us, and this includes their financial and personal information.

## **FCIA Middle East Events Rescheduled**

# BARRIER MANAGEMENT VIDEO RESOURCES ONLINE

CIA worked with the American Society for Healthcare Engineering (ASHE), The Joint Commission (TJC), and UL to develop and deliver the Barrier Management Symposium.

Part of the mission of this initiative was to provide a 'compendium of knowledge'. That compendium is a key part of FCIA's initiative to educate about the details required to 'D'esign, 'I'nstall, 'I'nspect, and 'M'anage fire-resistance-rated and smoke-resistant assemblies - the 'DIIM' of firestopping.

Health Care Facilities Managers and educational occupancy Facility Managers have a wealth of knowledge available to them with the <u>Barrier Management Symposium Video Series</u>. The video series, developed in collaboration

with ASHE, TJC, and UL, is available online and features 12 modules highlighting the various aspects of smoke and fire barrier management.

FCIA's Barrier Management Services section is also a direct result of the Barrier Management Symposiums. The FCIA Barrier Management Services was developed to assist building owners and managers in finding service providers for all areas of Barrier Management, including Barrier Surveys, Barrier Repairs, Firestop Systems, Fire and Smoke Dampers, Fire-Rated Rolling & Swinging Doors, Fire-Resistance-Rated Glazing, Barrier Management Software, and SFRM & IFRM Fireproofing Repairs. ## FCIA @ ASTM

CIA's Executive Director, Bill McHugh, is the chair of the ASTM E 2174 and ASTM E 2393 Firestop Inspection Standards Task Groups. As Task Group Chair, he submits ballots on behalf of and that have been approved by the Task Group, reviewed by the Subcommittee Chair to the voting process.

Several proposals were submitted to harmonize requirements in ASTM E 2393 Standard Practice for the On-Site Inspection of Fire-Resistive Joint Systems with ASTM E 2174, Standard Practice for the On-Site Inspection of Installed Firestops. While we recognize there are differences between penetrations and joints, there are many common elements that should be the same.

The FCIA Standards Committee Chair, Jay McGuire, and Bill McHugh attend ASTM Committee Meetings every six months. The first meeting scheduled for April 2020 was cancelled. We'll have to do what we were going to do in October, or via teleconference later this summer. Stay tuned at FCIA.org for updates.

# NEW ASTM LABEL STANDARD DEVELOPMENT CYCLES

CIA's Standards Chair Jay McGuire will be joining the new ASTM Task Group on Identification Systems – Labelling – for both penetration and joint firestop systems as the Task Group Chair. Due to COVID-19 precautions and group meeting restrictions in place, the task group will likely have to meet via webinar to look at the submitted draft so the process for code submissions in January 2021 is not delayed.


